THE CHANGES ...

C4 2018 was incredible! With over 350 people in attendance, we were right at 100% Camp Cotubic capacity. So, because we are expecting to see an increase in attendance this year, we had to make a few changes in order to make sure we don't have to turn people away from summer camp. Keep reading for details on these changes – the biggest things you (the youth leader/parent) need to be aware of are the *change in dates* and the *change in our registration process*.

Change in camp dates:

Remember how I said we were at 100% capacity at C4 2018? What I mean by this is that Camp Cotubic told us that we could not fit any more people in the camp facilities. Well, we don't like the idea of not being able to grow, so we had to find a creative solution – here's what we came up with:

We will be hosting two camps! Both camps will be identical – same speaker, same band, same activities, same schedule, same everything! Doing it this way allows us the opportunity to continue growing as we have been over the last few years. The dates for the two camps are:

Camp A: Sunday, June 23 – Wednesday, June 26

Camp B: Wednesday, June 26 – Saturday, June 29

You and your group will select and promote one of the above camps to attend (they are *not* split up by age or district). It is up to the leadership of your local ministry to determine whether they would like to promote Camp A or Camp B.

Change in registration process:

Registration is on a first come basis. Meaning, for example, if your church plans to attend Camp A, but you send in the registration for your church after Camp A has already hit capacity, you will be informed and invited to join us for Camp B. We recognize the possibility that one of the camps may fill up faster than the other. To streamline this process for students, leaders, and C4 staff, registration will be online this year. The only items that will be mailed will be your group registration paper, each person's medical liability form, and check. However, even all of those items can be submitted online via email (group tally and medical forms can be scanned and emailed, while *payments can be submitted online at nwonaz.org*).

WHEN IS C4?

Camp A: Sunday, June 23 – Wednesday, June 26

Camp B: Wednesday, June 26 – Saturday, June 29

Check-in is 3:30pm-5pm on each camp's respective start date

Camp dismissal is at 11 AM on each camp's respective end date

WHAT AGES CAN ATTEND?

Any student who has completed 6th grade through students who graduated high school in 2019.

WHAT ARE WE GOING TO DO AT C4?

C4 is an opportunity for students to gather together and enjoy a wide range of activities. It is designed as a DISCIPLESHIP event for teens at any point in their journey with Jesus. It is packed with great worship and relevant Bible-based speaking. Another fun part of C4 is joining together with people from all over Ohio and having a blast. The event is filled with various activities such as:

COST AND PAYMENT SCHEDULE

Churches can reserve a spot in a non-transferrable & non-refundable deposit at any time prior to the early registration deadline. The cost is \$25 per student and will go towards the cost of their registration, **but does not lock in the amount due.** The final price for each person will still be based on when their account is paid in full. Simply send in completed forms with a \$25 deposit per student. This will reserve space for them through May 20th. At that time, any registration not paid in full will be lost.

Refunds: If for any reason a refund is needed, it must be requested by June 10th. Requests for refunds after June 10th will not be accommodated. Special circumstances will be reviewed on a case by case basis.

The following is a chart of prices and deadlines. For each deadline, envelopes must be *postmarked* by the respective date – so that's the date you SEND your lists.

WHEN CAN I REGISTER?

Registration opens on March 1st 2019.

HOW TO REGISTER (your complete tutorial):

- 1) Distribute Registration Forms and Medical Release Forms to your group.
- 2) Use the blank space on each form to establish a date for them to be returned to you.
- 3) Collect all completed registration forms, SIGNED medical release forms, and fees.
- 4) Complete the Group Registration Form provided.
- 5) Fill out an online registration form for each participant (students and leaders)
 - a) Have one person (you or another leader) transfer the information from the paper registration form into the online registration forms for each participant.
 - b) Online registration forms will be available on the C4 page at nwonyi.org
 - a. Make sure you select the correct online form (for either camp A or camp B)
- 6) Mail or email the following items to **C4 2019 226 North Market St, Mt. Sterling, OH, 43143** or tdresbach@msnazarene.org
 - a) A signed, completed medical release form for each student and adult
 - b) Completed Group Talley Sheet (Early, Regular or Late depending on when you send it in)
- 7) Payment: If mailing a check – One (1) Church Check for all participant and adult registration fees made payable to **NWO NYI** mailed to the address in step 6. If paying online – Made through nwonaz.org/treasurers Click on the district funds tab and you will be redirected to our secure payment site All payments must be made by direct deposit in the C4 Registration designated block.

****Note:** Individual registration forms are to be submitted online, if they are mailed with the other registration items they will be returned to the sender so that they can be entered online.

MEDICAL RELEASE FORMS

We must have a signed medical release form on file for all in attendance. **No exceptions.** Be sure to mail (or email) these forms along with your registration fees and group tally form by the registration deadlines.

HOW MANY ADULTS SHOULD WE BRING?

We are requiring a minimum of 1 adult per 6 students and 1 adult per gender. So, if you have 5 girls and 1 boy, you'll need both a male and a female chaperone. "Adult" is defined as over 20 years of age. Adults should also be trained and approved volunteers from your church. We expect each of our churches sending teens to send an adult to camp. In the case that your church cannot provide a sponsor, it is your responsibility to assign that responsibility to another church, with their consent, prior to June 10.

Note: Your group is only expected to send adults to the camp your students attend.

Example: If your group attends Camp A, you will not be expected to send adults to Camp B. However, if you send students to both Camp A and Camp B, it will be expected that you send the appropriate number of adults to both camps or assign your students with another church.

WHAT SHOULD WE BRING

Yourself, Bible, Writing Utensils, Clothes, Modest Swimwear, Extra Cash for Snack Bar, Laundry Bag, Toiletries, Bed linens, Towels, Tennis Shoes, Flip Flops. Plan for hot weather! Plan also for mud and dirt. Also, some sleeping areas are separate from shower facilities. Plan accordingly.

WHAT SHOULD WE NOT BRING?

Normal contra-ban: Weaponry, Drugs, Alcohol, Tobacco, Fireworks, etc.

Student Vehicles: Please limit driving to adults during the event

Electronics: Please don't bring items that aren't absolutely necessary (We are not responsible for any losses).

This is an incomplete list and we reserve the right to confiscate items deemed inappropriate until the end of the event. Thanks for your understanding.
